



## Adult Tournament

Date: January 22-24<sup>th</sup>, 2010

Entry Deadline: Friday, January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2010 – “First-Come-First-Served”

There are a limited number of spaces available per division so guarantee your spot by registering now!!!  
The registration deadline for an Early-Bird Discount is December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009!!!

### Mens & Womens Divisions

#### Competitive

- Entry Fee: \$590 per team – Early bird special - Registration after Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009 is \$650
- Prize: 1<sup>st</sup> place = \$1,200 – 2<sup>nd</sup> place = \$600
- 8v8 format (including goal keeper) on “half-field” (200’x150’)
- Player Eligibility: All players welcome - intended for RSA Prem/Div 2 or top 2 divisions in other districts
- Space is limited – fully paid entries will be accepted on a “first-come-first-served” basis.

#### Recreational 1

- Entry Fee: \$390 per team – Early bird special - Registration after Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009 is \$425
- Prize: 1<sup>st</sup> place = \$1,000 – 2<sup>nd</sup> place = \$400
- 6v6 (including goalkeeper) format on “quarter-field” (150’x96’)
- Player Eligibility: Intended for RSA Division 3 - Players registered in RSA Division 2 or higher or top 2 divisions in other districts are not eligible.
- Space is limited – fully paid entries will be accepted on a “first-come-first-served” basis.

#### Recreational 2

- Entry Fee: \$390 per team – Early bird special - Registration after Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009 is \$425
- Prize: 1<sup>st</sup> place = \$1,000 – 2<sup>nd</sup> place = \$400
- 6v6 (including goalkeeper) format on “quarter-field” (150’x96’)
- Player Eligibility: Intended for RSA Divisions 4 and 5 - Players registered in RSA Division 3 or higher or top 3 divisions in other districts are not eligible.
- Space is limited – fully paid entries will be accepted on a “first-come-first-served” basis.

### Co-ed Divisions

- Co-ed is not being offered at the RSA Adult Tournament this year due to growth in Mens and Womens Divisions and limited facility time.

## **Other Tournament Information**

All tournament registrations must be completed using the Regina Soccer Association's online registration system. Space is limited; therefore entries will be accepted on a "first come, first served" basis.

- All teams are guaranteed 3 round-robin games. Divisions with 8 or more teams registered will have playoff rounds consisting of semi-finals and finals.
- Teams may sign as many "guest players" as they wish. However, all players (including guest players) must be registered (and in good standing) within their district and must not be "playing down" to a lower division in this tournament.
- The Tournament Organizing Committee may combine or cancel divisions in the event not enough teams are registered in any particular division. This will be communicated to teams prior to release of the schedule and full refunds will be offered.
- The Tournament Organizing Committee reserves the right to move to teams up to a higher tournament division if they are deemed to not belong in the division requested.
- Once a team is accepted, fees are non-refundable and the RSA is not responsible for refunding fees due to severe weather or other events outside the control of the RSA.
- If your team is not accepted, you will be placed on a waiting list and accepted at a later date if space becomes available.
- Schedules will be sent out around January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010. All tournament information will be available on the RSA website. Please check for updates. Out of town teams will be scheduled to play later Friday evening or early Saturday morning. Local teams may be scheduled for games as early as 5PM on Friday.
- Complete team rosters will need to be emailed to the RSA office by Wed Jan 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 @ 5PM. For your convenience, your rosters will be pre-printed on the tournament game sheets. No roster changes will be able to be made after the roster deadline of Wed Jan 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 @ 5PM.
- All teams from districts other than the RSA must ensure their district office emails the RSA office verifying the accuracy of the roster and that all players on the roster are currently registered and in good standing in that district. All out-of-province teams must have a travel permit.

## **Register Your Team Now**

With our online system, registration is easy!!! All tournament registrations must be completed using the Regina Soccer Association's online registration system. A valid credit card is required for fee payment. The team manager (or designated individual) must personally register their team online and pay the registration fee via credit card.

You will receive an email from the RSA office to confirm that your registration & entry fee were received prior to the deadline. If you do not receive an email from the RSA office within 1 business day of your registration, then it is your responsibility to contact the RSA office to inquire on the status of your registration.
