 - You will be issued a cheque for this amount after April 30th
- **In order to declare a team:** 4 players must be registered & paid in full by **April 22nd**
 - Players can either register online or in the RSA Office.
 - These registration costs are non-refundable.
 - The RSA may accept late team registrations, but a late fee of \$300 will apply.
 - **In order to be scheduled:** a total of 10 players must be registered & paid in full by **April 29th**
 - **In order to be eligible to play in league play:** a total of 14 players must be registered & paid in full by **May 10th**

Fees:

Adult Fees are as follows:

Men's Division 2	\$230 per player (to be confirmed)
Men's Division 3	\$190 per player
Men's Division 4	\$185 per player
Men's Division 5	\$185 per player
Women's Division 2/3	\$185 per player
Women's Division 4/5	\$165 per player
All Co-ed Divisions	\$145 per player
Co-ed Player also registered on a Men's or Women's Team	\$85 per player

*The fee for Cheques returned by the bank for any reason is \$25.00

Roster Sizes:

- Men's and women's teams must register a minimum of 14 players.
- Teams will play 11 aside including the keeper.

- Coed teams must register a minimum of 14 players.
- Teams will play 8 aside including the keeper.

Number of Games

- **Div 2 Men's**– will play approximately 16 – 18
(approximately 14 - 16 regular + approximately 2 playoff games)
- **Division 3-5 Men's & Div 2 –5 Women's** – will play approximately 18 games
(16 regular season games + approximately 2 playoff games)
- **All Co-ed Divisions** – will play approximately 16 games a season
(14 regular season games + approximately 2 playoff games)

Adult Leagues and Divisions:

Depending on number of teams registered, divisions may play in an interlocking or combined schedule.

Men's League

Will consist of the following divisions depending upon the number of teams registered:

- Division 2 Men
- Division 3 Men
- Division 4 Men
- Division 5 Men

Women's League

Will consist of the following divisions depending upon the number of teams registered:

- Division 2 Women
- Division 3 Women
- Division 4/5 Women

* Division 2 and 3 Women will likely play a combined or interlocking schedule.

Co-ed League

Will consist of the following divisions depending upon the number of teams registered:

- **Division 1 (Premiere)**
 - All players are welcome to play in this division.

- **Division 2 (Competitive)**
 - No player registered in Men's PSL/Premiere may play on a team in this division.
 - Maximum 2 players registered in Men's Division 2 may play on a team in this division.

- **Division 3 (Semi-Competitive)**
 - No player registered in Men's Division 2 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - Maximum 2 players registered in Men's Division 3 may play on a team in this division.

- **Division 4 (Recreational)**
 - No player registered in Men's Division 3 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - Maximum 2 players registered in Men's Division 4 may play on a team in this division.

- **Division 5 (Novice)**
 - This division is meant for teams who are almost entirely made up of beginner recreational players. Teams who do not appear to belong in this division will be moved to a higher division at the discretion of the RSA.
 - No player registered in Men's Division 4 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Women's Div 3 or higher may play on a team in this division.

Schedules:

If there are any dates where your team is unable to play, please make a **request** to the office **in writing before April 26th**. Please include reasons why.

All Schedules are to be obtained from the RSA website at www.reginasoccer.com after **May 3rd**.

League Play will start on **May 10th**.

Game Sheets:

Game sheets will be obtained from the RSA Website.

It is the responsibility of the HOME TEAM to bring the printed off game sheet.

The Official will obtain the game sheet to be returned to the RSA office.

Both Teams are to email in the game score the following day to results@reginasoccer.com

It is each manager's responsibility to:

- Cross off any players not in attendance
- Ensure that it is recorded that any players are serving a suspension
- Add jersey numbers
- Add any guest players
- Email in the game score the following day to results@reginasoccer.com
