NEW GAME SHEET & PLAYER ID ROSTER FORM

The Regina Soccer Association is pleased to announce that beginning with games scheduled from June 14th forward there will be an improved Game Sheet and a new, simplified player identification process. (Game sheets released Friday, June 11.)

GAME SHEET

1. Additional lines have been added to allow teams to list up to twenty-four (24) players on the game sheet.
2. Additional space has been added to include up to four (4) team officials.
3. To address privacy concerns players are listed by last name and first initial.
4. Jersey Numbers will sort K, 1 to 99.

PICTURE ROSTER SHEET (PRS)

1. A PRS will print as page 2 with the game sheet and will be created with the most current information about your team. The sheet will follow the same order as the Game Sheet. Registered players will be accurate up to the time it is posted to the web site.
2. Pictures of the registered team Coaches and Manager(s) will appear in the first four positions of the Roster Sheet.
3. A team member or official whose picture does not appear on the sheet is either

missing from the RSA database or he/she does not have an ID card. Contact the RSA office before your next game to remedy this. Game sheets are posted approximately one week in advance. Players registering late or whose picture does not appear on the PRS can present their Player ID Card to the officials to play before the next game cycle is posted.

IDENTIFICATION PROCEDURE

1. The Home Team is responsible to print and provide the Game Sheet and the Picture Roster Sheet to the officials prior to the game. It is recommended that the Visitor Team also print the Picture Roster Sheet as a backup.
2. Players are to line up in the order they appear on the Picture Roster Sheet to allow for speedy check-in by the game officials.
3. The game officials will use the Roster Sheet to confirm each player's identity and will submit the Roster with the Game sheet to the RSA office.

Affiliated Guest Player (AGP) process remains the same. Players are manually added to the game sheet and present their Player ID Card for Identification.

Non-Affiliated Guest Player (NGP) process remains unchanged. The NGP receives a

series of guest passes that contain his/her photograph. This is presented to the game official who will note the player on the Game Sheet and apply the sticker to it.

The Home team is responsible for bringing the correct Game Sheet and Picture Roster Sheet for both teams. Both teams are required to provide the required field equipment. If these items are missing, then the teams will be charged a fine. Referees can show some flexibility here and that flexibility should increase for divisions that are more recreational. In the spirit of the game, opposing teams should also show good sportsmanship and provide the other team with the missing forms or equipment whenever possible.

In the event that there is no Picture Roster Sheet present for the game, all players and team officials will be required to produce their ID Cards in order to participate.

We trust that this new process will speed up the accreditation and identification process and allow the participants more time to enjoy the game.
