Online Registration:

Starting **August 21st**, players will be able to register online. To have your team setup on our website please email to Nicole@reginasoccer.com:

5. A per player team fee (optional): This is a separate amount that may be collected from each player (for team equipment, jerseys, practice time, etc). You will be issued a cheque for this amount after October 30th.

Adult Leagues and Divisions:

Divisions may play in an interlocking or combined schedule, depending on number of teams registered.

Based on previous seasons' standings, the Adult Competition Committee may move teams up or down divisions. If a division change is required, the team will be notified by email prior to the release of the schedules. Players will either be refunded or be required to pay the difference in fees.

Men's League

* Dependent on the number of teams registered, a Preseason Qualifying Tournament may be necessary to determine the teams in Men's Division 2 and 3. See further information below under "**Men's Division 2 and 3 Preseason Qualifying Tournaments**".

Co-ed League

Please note: the co-ed divisions have been revised for this upcoming season.

- Division 1/2 (Premiere/Competitive)
 - Intended for players registered in Men's PSL/Div 2 and Women's PSL/Div 2, however all players are allowed to play in this division.
- Division 3 (Semi-Competitive)
 - Intended for players registered in Men's Div 3 and Women's Div 3.
 - No player registered in Men's Division 2 or higher may play on a team in this division.
- Division 4 (Advanced Recreational)
 - Intended for players registered in Men's Div 4 and Women's Div 4/5.
 - No player registered in Men's Division 3 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Women's Division 2 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Youth U18 PSL/Division 1 may play on a team in this division.
- Division 5 (Recreational)
 - Intended for players registered in Men's Div 5 and Women's Div 4/5.
 - No player registered in Men's Division 4 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Women's Division 3 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Youth U18 PSL/Division 1 or U16 PSL/Division 1 may play on a team in this division.
- Division 6 (Novice)
 - Intended for players new to the game of soccer so they can learn to play "the beautiful game" in a fun & pressure-free environment.
 - No player registered in Men's Division 5 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Women's Division 3 or higher may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Youth U18 PSL/Division 1 or U16 PSL/Division 1 may play on a team in this division.
 - No player registered in Youth U18 Division 2 may play on a team in this division

Men's Division 2 and 3 Preseason Qualifying Tournaments:

Depending on the number of teams registered in Men's Division 2 and 3, preseason qualifying tournaments (PQTs) may be necessary.

Teams who have not previously registered in Division 2 or 3 are **not** eligible to register in Division 2.

If required, the tournaments will take place between **October 1st and 5th**. All teams participating in the tournaments will be required to pay a tournament entry fee to cover the cost of officials and fields. The fee will be dependent on the number of entries, but will be approximately \$300-\$375 per team.

Players will be required to be registered on the team roster by **September 29th** in order to be eligible for the tournament.

Teams not qualifying and moving down divisions will be refunded the difference in registration fees. The PQT entry fee will not be refunded.

Further information on the PQTs will be sent out to teams after the team declaration deadline, **September 21st**.

Fees and Deadlines:

- **In order to declare a team**, Four players must be registered & paid in full by **September 21st**

These 4 registration costs are non-refundable, but are transferrable.

The RSA may accept late team registrations. A late fee of \$20/player will apply (up to the roster minimum).

- **Premier/Division 2 & 3 Men's and Division 2 Women's teams:**
 - 10 players must be registered and paid in full prior to or on **October 4th**
 - 14 players must be register and paid in full prior to or on **October 14th**
- **Division 4-6 Men's and Division 3-5 Women's and all Co-ed teams:**
 - 8 players must be registered and paid in full prior to or on **October 4th**
 - 11 players must be registered and paid in full prior to or on **October 14th**

Teams not reaching these minimums before will not be scheduled or will be fined.

Adult Fees are as follows (Includes base fee, referees' fee, SSA fee and the District Registration fee):

Men's Premier and Division 2	\$255 per player
Men's Division 3	\$255 per player

Women's Premier and Division 2	\$235 per player
Women's Division 3	\$200 per player
Women's Division 4	\$185 per player*
Women's Division 5	\$185 per player*
All Co-ed Divisions	\$165 per player
Co-ed Player also registered on a Men's or Women's Team	\$95 per player

The fee for Cheques returned by the bank for any reason is \$25.00

* The increase in Women's 4 and 5 reflects the change to include additional game officials.

Roster Sizes:

Premier/Division 2 & 3 Men's and Women's Division 2

Teams must register a **minimum of 14 players** for the indoor season.
Teams will play 8 aside including a keeper.

Division 4-6 Men's and Division 3-5 Women's

Teams must register a **minimum of 11 players** for the indoor season.
Teams will play 6 aside including the keeper.

All Co-ed Divisions

Teams must register a **minimum of 11 players** for the indoor season.
Teams will play 6 aside including the keeper.

Number of Games

- **Premier and Div 2 & 3 Men's & Women's Division 2** – will play approximately 16 games/season (about 14 regular season/exhibition games + about 2 playoff games)
- **Division 4-6 Men's & Division 3-5 Women's** – Will play approximately 18 games a season
(16 regular season/exhibition games + approximately 2 playoff games)
- **All Co-ed Divisions** – Will play approximately 16 games a season
(14 regular season/exhibition games + approximately 2 playoff games)
